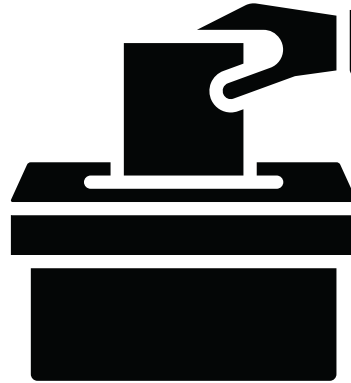

to pray for Holiday Club.

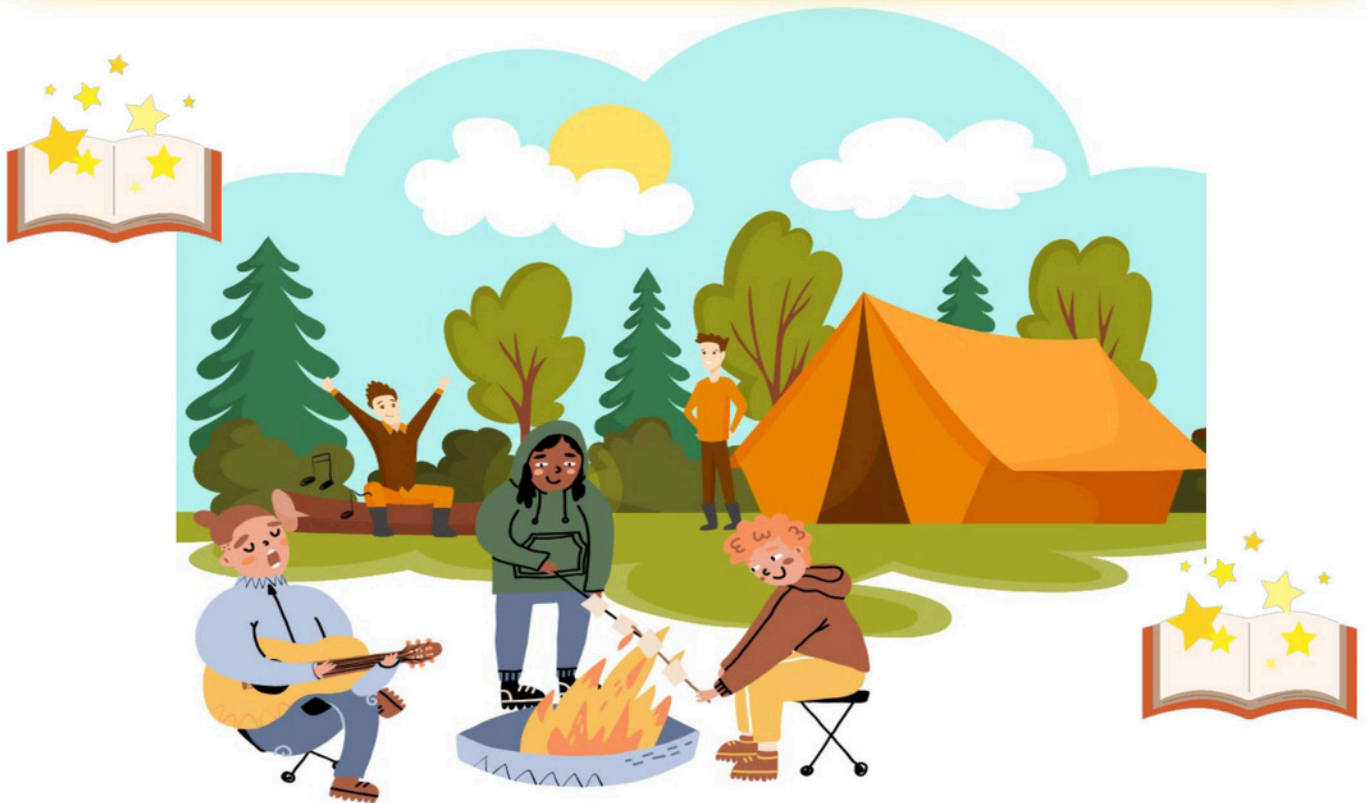
